

“Learn About Irish Bogs” Instructions

▶▶▶ Carefully Read and Follow These Instructions ◀◀◀

Please advise the person who volunteers after you to read them as well.

- Read all the information boards about Irish bogs so you have an understanding of Irish bogs and where people can find answers.
- People of all ages are welcome to participate.
- Make sure each participant older than 5 has a green or orange wristband. If not, politely inform them that they need to purchase a wristband at the festival entrance to participate in any festival activities.
- When people come to this area, hand out a worksheet and pencil to each person and tell them that if they answer all the questions correctly they get to take a piece of authentic Irish peat home with them.
- Each information board with an answer to one of the questions has a number attached to it so people know where to go to get the answer for that question number.
- When they bring the sheet to you, check their answers. If any are incorrect, help them find the correct answers. Once they are all correct, put a star on the top of their worksheet, let them take the worksheet with them and let them choose their piece of Irish peat to take with them.
- If you are on the 4-6 pm volunteer shift, between 5-6 pm, pack up all the items on this table in the box. When you finish, go to one of the tables that didn't need a volunteer, and pack up those items in its box.
- If anyone needs help or advice please offer it to them in a polite and friendly manner so everyone feels welcome and enjoys this experience.
- When the next volunteer arrives to take your place, share hints or wisdom you acquired during your shift.
- Please return your Volunteer Badge to the Check-in Table.
